Session 3: July 12 - 16

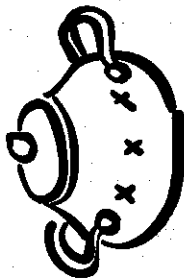

Session 4: July 19 - 23

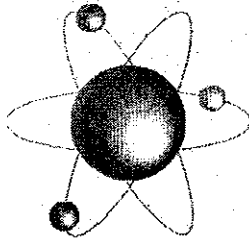
