

MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION

Pal Camp Policies and Procedures

A Parent/Guardian must fill out the attached forms in order for Pal Camp's Director to administer any sort of medications—prescribed or over the counter drugs. Pal Camp needs to be aware of any special needs or medications (including Aspirin, Benadryl, cough syrup, cough drops) your child may need. If your child had medication that is not registered with our Camp Director, it will be confiscated and returned to the Parent/Guardian at first contact.

Parents who are authorizing the Camp Director to give their child a prescribed or over the counter medication must include the following information:

- A child proof container, preferably the original, with the child's first and last name.
- A dated note from the Parent with specific instructions for storing and administering the medication.
- Name of the health care provider who recommended the medication.
- The expiration date of the medication.
- A medical information and release form (below).
